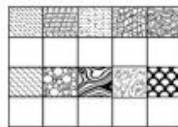
Be a weather watcher...

Reading

Reading is a Key part to your child's progression in all subjects. Reading should be enjoyable and time to talk about what has been read. I would like this to be the focus at home.

A book to share will be sent home each week. This book should be read twice at home before it is changed in school. Also, each child will bring home a book from the class library each week.

As part of our new Phonics scheme each child will read with an adult three times a week. In each session the same book will be read with a different focus in each session. Detailed information will be given in my parent's session Thursday 29th September.

We have a story session daily to promote the enjoyment of reading and promote discussions about books.

High quality texts will be used throughout the year to support the children's learning across the curriculum.
